The Mind and the Role it Plays in the Christian Life

Proverbs 23:7

- 1. The mind is the place in which our <u>thoughts</u>, <u>reasonings</u>, <u>attitudes</u>, and <u>values</u> are determined, which in turn dictate the directions our lives take.
- 2. It should come as no surprise to us, then, that the Word of God places great emphasis upon the mind of the child of God, because as a man thinketh, so he is.
- 3. The mind plays an incredibly important part in the life of a Christian, more than you may understand and think.
- 4. In Amos 3:3, God asks what question? Read the context to get a better appreciation of the significance of the question:
- 5. Jesus gave an astounding invitation to a few fishermen in Matthew 4:18-22. Amazingly, he continues to give this invitation to us today. What <u>must</u> be understood by us—as it was by the early disciples—is <u>if</u> we choose to answer this call to follow Jesus, we need to <u>repent</u>. Define repentance:
